Here are some of the steps the **#NotMe** organizations take to enhance safety before & during live events:

1

Set expectations:

Publish your Code of Conduct

and make it easily accessible to all (event's website, on the #NotMe newsfeed, etc.)

2

Make sure ticket buyers and attendees acknowledge and agree to the terms of your code of conduct at the time of ticket purchase.

3

Partner with #NotMe – the expert company in speak up & anonymous reporting – to ensure that attendees have an easy, trusted & safe way to report issues.

4

Encourage the attendees to connect to the #NotMe app before the event so they are ready to report incidents quickly and easily, if – and when – needed.

5

Prominent Signage: Print the #NotMe app QR code on event tickets or badges and place clear and visible signs throughout the venue grounds, indicating how attendees can safely report concerns anonymously (if desired).

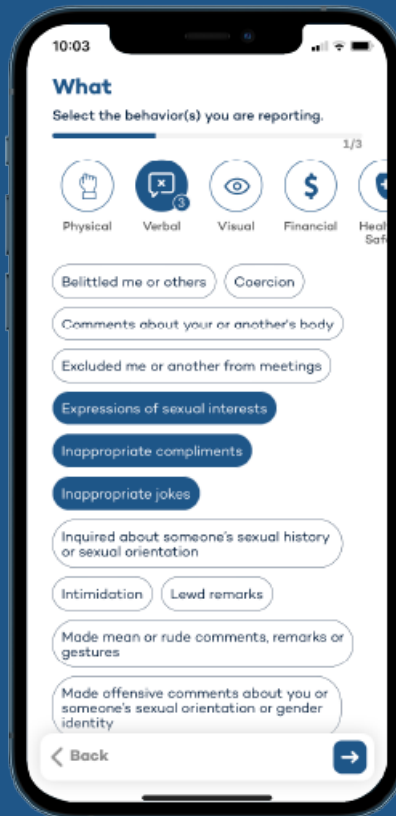
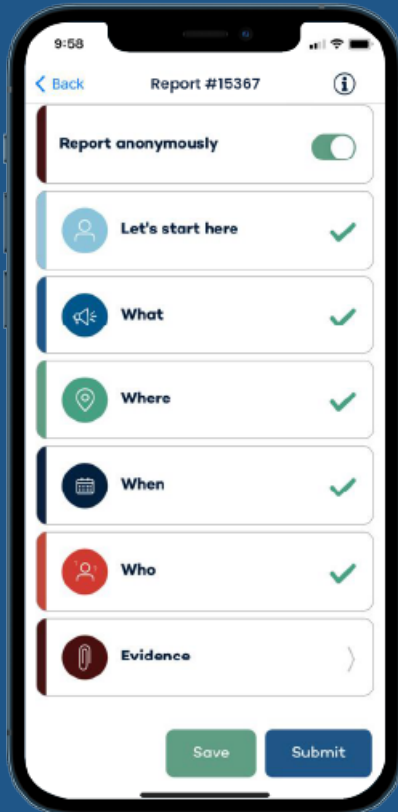

Make sure your event's staff gets trained on misconduct prevention & handling and is ready to handle reports.

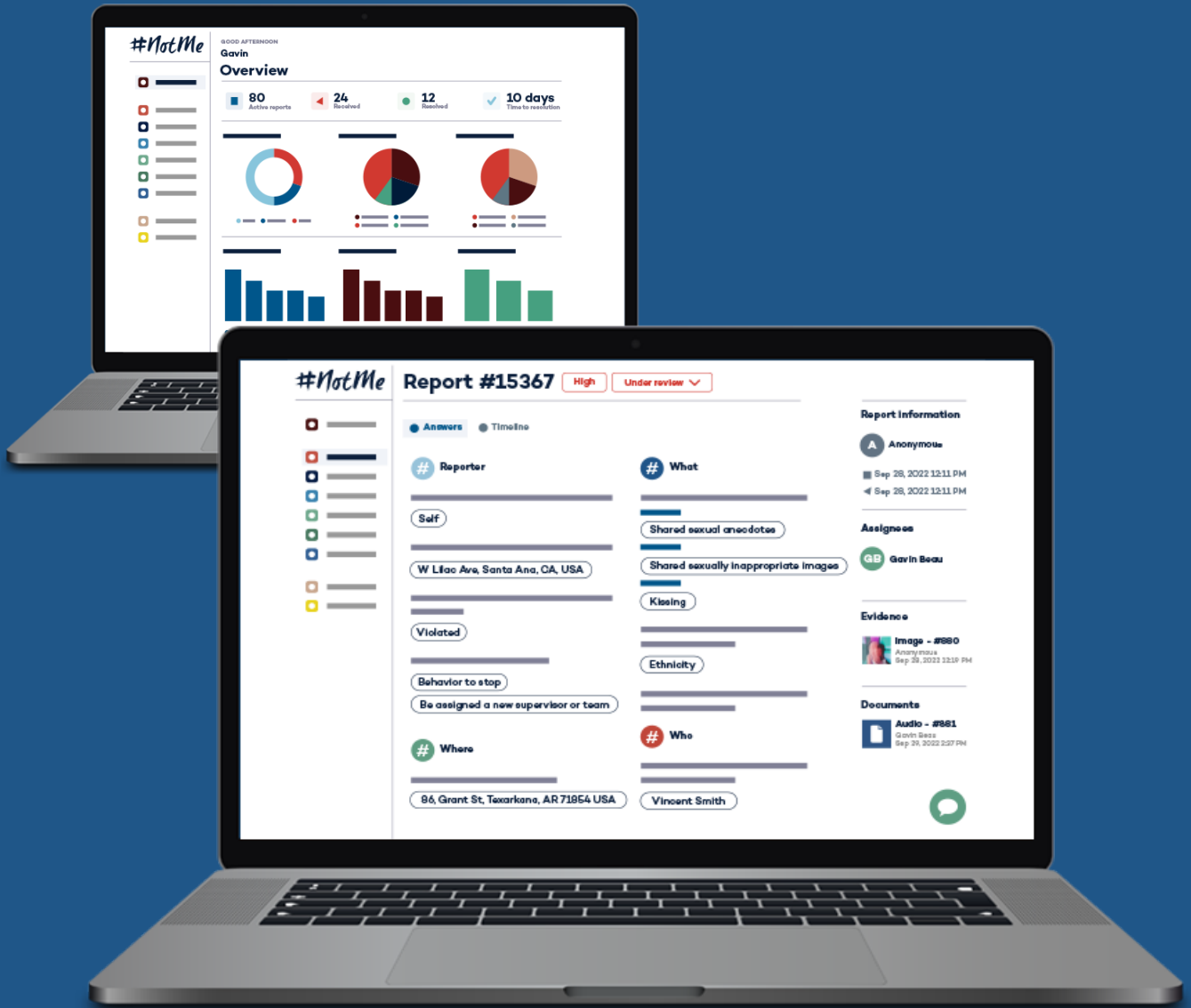
Immediate Response: Ensure that there is a team dedicated to monitoring and responding to anonymous reports in real-time. This might involve security personnel, medical staff, and event organizers.
